NEW RECORD

February saw the highest amount of theme bags and books delivered in a month since our ELRL launched in 2014 – along with the most deliveries ever made.

Thanks to our amazing donor, our wonderful Library team – and huge thanks to the volunteers who help making sure all items are returned, cleaned and packed ready for the next ECD Centre to use. There are currently 53 ECD Centres registered as members of our ELRL – way beyond our wildest dreams when we launched in a container all those years ago!

Theme bags delivered 141

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Books delivered 720

Deliveries made 105 (previous monthly record: 71)





ECD FOUNDATION TRAINING

Our training started on a positive and productive note with 20 ECD practitioners and 4 ECD principals attending our newly created Foundation Training. This 4 day training lays the groundwork in preparation for our Early Learning Program (ELP) courses which commenced in February.



EARLY LEARNING PROGRAM (ELP)

Theme-based ELP 0 - 3 and ELP 3 - 5 group training takes place with 10 participants each attending fortnightly training (20 ECD Centres in total). Teachers receive wonderful resources, mentoring visits and extra input by our OT to ensure maximum implementation within the Centres and to ensure all children benefit from the learning program. Thus far we have covered 5 themes.



INCLUSIVE LEARNING

In March we presented a 5 day Inclusive Learning Course for 41 principals and educators from 39 ECD Centres – thanks to our long-term donors and supporters, Lombard Insurance.

This course was aimed at equipping educators with knowledge and practical intervention methods to effectively work with young children who are at different stages of ability and development.



Inclusive Education presented the first two days of the course on how to ensure that all children on varying developmental levels are benefitting from activities and that every child is learning and taking part. ORT SA Cape Education presented the following two days covering Perceptual Skills Training and Level 1 Lego-training. The last day was hosted by Marilet van Rooyen and Eloise Grobbelaar, specialists in autism and neurodiversity, on how to manage different behaviours in the classroom setting.

Thank you to Jeanine Andro for very successfully facilitating this excellent course and to Karen Bufé for presenting the interactive session on Body Moves to finish off the week.

Training and mentoring - the core of what we do - is made possible by our much-valued monthly donors and generous support from Cheafrica, Kiewitfonds, Lombard Insurance and Upside Trust.

>>> ECD RESOURCES

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The ECD Centres we work with are situated in marginalised communities and most of them have very little space in which to work, play, store resources, etc. Thankfully Golden Sunbeams e.V., one of our long-term and very special partners, was swift to come on board and fund the installation of over 1120 bag hooks at 30 of these Centres.

These school bag hooks not only free up space, they also help to instill good habits, reduce clutter, and keep bags and their contents in better condition.





NUTRITION
